

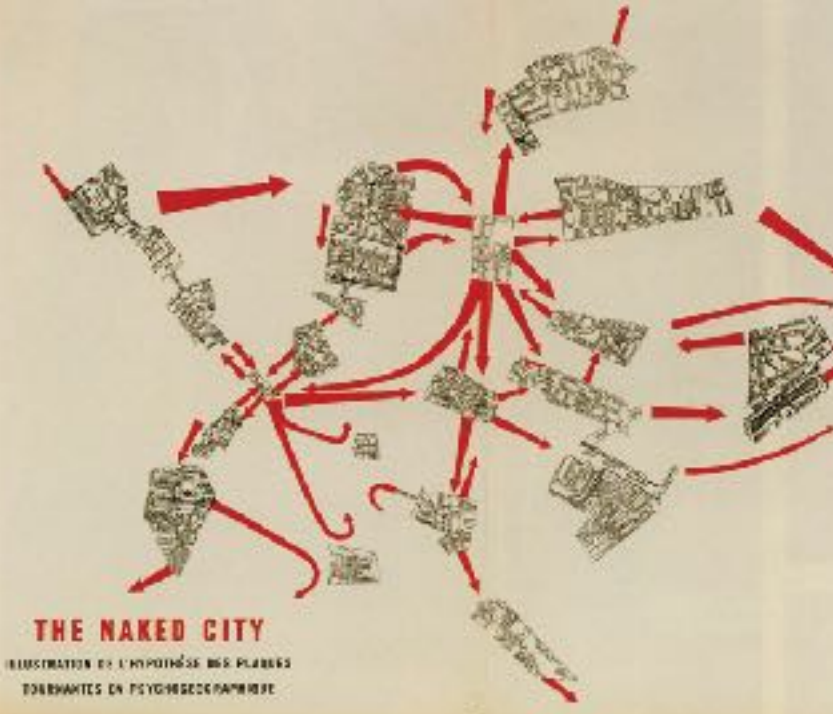

psychogeography > storytelling



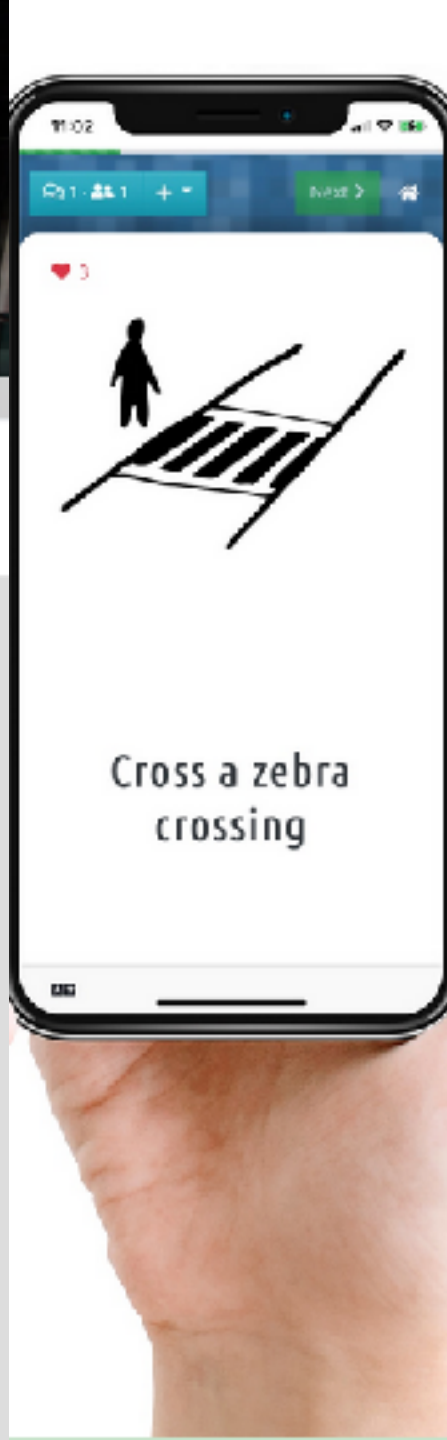
